Requiring Policies for IQA Members

Rulebook Changes

- Brian Gallaway raises concerns on the potential reintroduction of defensive charging of a ball carrier.
- The board requests a risk assessment for their rule changes from the rulebook team.
 - Recommendation to consult somebody with suitable expertise on safety and rules in sport.
