Questions

Alex (CAN) asks if the income on PayPal should be moved into a bank account. Rahel (IQA) replies that this is the plan, but it is held up with the bank account.

Matt (GBR) asks if there is a problem with referring to income as profit or loss due to the current non-profit status of the IQA, as it is a point raised for QUK by their accountant. Rahel (IQA) replies that it is not something that has been risen up yet and may be different in US law but that she will look into it to confirm that the language does not need changing.

Ajantha (AUS) asks who is eligible for the development fund if it is for the general development of the sport or development of NGBs, and how it is decided who is approved for this. Austin (IQA) replies that it focuses on developing within the NGBs, it was decided that sending players to World Cup is not the best use of this as the long term impact is higher when focused within the country rather than on travel to World Cup to prepare them to attend these tournaments in the future.

Rike (IQA) replies that Emerging areas and developing regions are eligible to apply.

Ajantha (AUS) asks if the IQA has plans to support the Asian Cup in the future. Pauline (IQA) replies that the events department has contacted the NGBs within the area to ask how they can support a local tournament however, there have been limited responses, so she is unable to give further information.

Matt (GBR) asks if continental games could benefit from moving to a longer cycle and World Cup moving to 3 or 4-year cycles, using continental games as development events to allow more extended training for World Cup and times for NGBs to develop between these.

Pauline (IQA) replies that this is being discussed in the Events Department and may be presented to the Board of Trustees. It is focussing on for the future however, this will not be for the next cycle.

Matt (QUK) follows up by asking when there will be an update on attending countries for World Cup.

Pauline (IQA) replies that this will be by March 10

Ajantha (AUS) asks if the IQA will have a strategic planning committee or general strategic plan. Pauline (IQA) replies that there is a committee chaired by Pauline and Rahel (IQA), together with IQA volunteers, which are working on the strategic planning process. Emma (NZ) Asia-Oceanic continental games, Emma is heading this conversation in the region and will contact the IQA, asking people in the region with questions to reach out to her.

Motion to approve the Treasurer's Report (incl. Financial Report 2019), the ED's Report / Operations Report, and the Chair's Report. Moved: Jannis (CHE) Seconded: Matt (GBR) For: CHE, FRA, AUS, POL, DEU, BEL, USQ, CAN, ITA, NOR, ARG, GBR, ESP - Unanimous HKG voices approval

Motion passes.

Election of Trustees

The candidates are presented to the Assembly.

Jannis (CHE) asks if the committee recommends a specific number of trustees to vote in Pauline (IQA) answers no.

Matt (GBR) asks if nine members on the board are needed or if less would be functional. Rahel (IQA) answers that according to the constitution, between four and twelve are needed. At the start of this boards term, they split their term lengths so that three people left at each year. The number is up to the members depending on how many they think will be suited to the role. Pauline (IQA) replies that the board has been functioning at seven for a while and that more people are not needed; however would be beneficial if they hold different specialties.

Ajantha (AUS) asks if the IQA would be best supported by having these volunteers on the board or filling volunteer positions needed in other positions in the IQA.

Matt (GBR) answers that some of those roles would be better filled by people with professional experience in those areas.

Austin (IQA) replies that those roles do also need filling, but that if people have applied for the board, they should not be turned down for other positions in the organization With board members also holding volunteer roles elsewhere in the IQA, more board members would allow them more time to focus on their other IQA duties.

Advisory Council

The council is to be a committee that can be approached for smaller IQA decisions that do not warrant full discussion of the members but can be used to give advice or suggestions to the trustees. This committee would be made up of a subsection of IQA members.

Ajantha (AUS) thinks that it is a good idea and would like to hear how it would be decided who is on the committee.

Austin (IQA) answers that it is up to the members and would be impacted by how many would be interested in being involved.

There is an initial interest in the idea of forming a council however, no specifics as to who would be involved yet. Discussion to continue in the IQA members slack at a later date.

Branding of Quidditch

Ajantha (AUS) comments that Quidditch Australia has concluded that the name of quidditch is beneficial to their growth due to the recognizable nature of the name and that they would like to keep the name of 'quidditch' for the next few years.

Austin (IQA) replies that it is a long term decision to make and would not be a change that happens soon unless there is an emergency.

Ajantha (AUS) expresses that using a trademarked name could be an issue for gaining sport recognition in Australia but they still prefer to keep the name for now.

Marian (POL) states that having the name in Poland is useful to draw Harry Potter fans into the sport and that it is useful for promotion.

Matt (GBR) suggests that this is not so important within the UK and, while it is not a negative, it is not a positive either.

Ajantha (AUS) highlights the importance of using the name quidditch within the sport's youth side.

Ajantha (AUS) asks if the rules have been copied out from the book if it is a problem.

Austin (IQA) replies that the problem is not that we play the sport from the book, but the used words are legally protected. This sets legal precedence.

Megan (USA) points out that there are limitations to the funding teams can have if quidditch stays the sport's name.

Austin (IQA) confirms this is a problem and is going over the suggestions mentioned by NGBs in the meeting chat.

Ajantha (AUS) asks if this discussion is to get a sense of what NGBs want or if it is about going to an actual discussion, and how the IQA intends to proceed.

Alex (CAN) says that getting a sense of where all NGBs are at is more important, a general feeling that most NGBs benefit more from still keeping the name quidditch.

Albert (IQA) says that we can look into the priorities per membership status level.

Austin (IQA) says this conversation was very useful. We will be leaning on the advisory council to get a short and long-term plan. We will reconvene later and get a sense of the members and community regarding the branding.
